Information

The European Research Council (ERC) is the first pan-European funding body supporting the **best frontier research** in Europe. It aims to provide attractive, **long-term funding** to **excellent scien-tists** and their research teams to pursue ground-breaking, high-risk/high-gain research in any field. Excellence is the sole criterion for selection; there are neither thematic priorities, nor geographical quotas for funding. The workshop will focus on:

- <u>ERC Starting Grants</u> for early-career researchers to develop their career and establish their own team (2-7 years after PhD)
- <u>ERC Consolidator Grants</u> for already independent excellent researchers (7-12 years after PhD)

The ERC publishes calls once a year. The **opening** and the **deadlines** for the 2020 call are as follows:

- ERC Starting grants: Opening: 17 July 2019 / Deadline: 16. October 2019
- ERC Consolidator grants: Opening: 24 October 2019 / Deadline: 04. February 2020

The two-day proposal-writing workshop supports the applicants to develop their proposals, by combining group work and targeted comments on their abstract and CV from the trainer.
